



Tadoku: Extensive Reading in Secondary Schools & Higher Education

Nowadays *tadoku*, or extensive reading, has become established in many secondary schools and institutions of higher education. Indeed, *tadoku* has become a kind of rage (!) at some schools and colleges. I will describe how and why *Oxford Reading Tree*, a reading programme for younger learners, got it all started.

Kunihide Sakai is Associate Professor at Tokyo Denki Tsushin University and President of the Extensive Reading Association of Japan. He has taught English at various levels at for over thirty years, and has published three books on *tadoku*. He has also co-authored several others, including *Reading a Million Words in the Classroom*. "Nobody knows better than I do, really, about *tadoku*, in Japan.:)"
